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### GOLDEN STATE BANCORP ANNOUNCES RECORD OPERATING RESULTS AND A NEW STOCK REPURCHASE PROGRAM

Glendale, CA, August 12, 2025 - Golden State Bancorp (OTCQX: GSBX) ("us," "we," "our," or the "Company"), the holding company of Golden State Bank (the "Bank"), today announced record financial results for the second quarter of 2025.

#### **Current Quarter Highlights:**

- Total assets increased by \$81.4 million, or 9.7%, from \$836.9 million at December 31, 2024 to \$918.2 million.
- Loans, net of deferred fees, increased by \$75.7 million, or 10.7%, from \$709.6 million at December 31, 2024 to \$785.3 million.
- Credit quality remains strong.
- Cash and cash equivalents of \$123.9 million at June 30, 2025.
- Deposits increased by \$72.0 million, or 10.1%, from \$712.7 million at December 31, 2024 to \$784.7 million.
- Net income of \$2.5 million for the three months ended June 30, 2025, and \$4.3 million year to date, a 15.1% increase over the first six months of 2024.
- Fully diluted book value per share of \$26.64 at June 30, 2025.

Mr. Robert H. Setrakian, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of the Company stated, "The strong results reflect the strength of our core business plan and efficiency of our operations as we continue to drive long-term shareholder value. Our continued focus entering the second half of the year is centered around leveraging off the solid platform we have built and continuing the momentum of building a solid balance sheet, liquidity and the retention and expansion of our valuable client base."

The Company also announced today that its Board of Directors has approved a new stock repurchase program authorizing the repurchase of up to \$2,000,000 of shares of the Company's common stock. The repurchase program will expire on December 31, 2025, unless terminated sooner by the Board of Directors.

Under the stock repurchase program, the Company may purchase shares of its common stock through various means, such as open market transactions, including block purchases, and privately negotiated transactions. The number of shares repurchased and the timing, manner, price, and amount of any repurchases will be determined at the Company's discretion. Factors include, but are not limited to, stock price, trading volume and general market conditions, along with the Company's general business conditions. The program may be suspended or discontinued at any time and does not obligate the Company to acquire any specific number or value of shares of its common stock.

Mr. Setrakian, added, "We are always focused on maximizing shareholder value. We have significant growth opportunities ahead of us, always maintain healthy liquidity and are nicely profitable. At the same time, we believe

that our shares are undervalued. Accordingly, our Board of Directors has decided that implementing this buyback is a prudent use of a small portion of our excess cash. We will continue evaluating all our growth opportunities and all other ways to allocate our capital and resources to enhance shareholder value."
